## BIKE CAMPS

This bicycle education camp is "geared" towards kids who can ride on two wheels for up to 1.5 miles on their own without assistance. 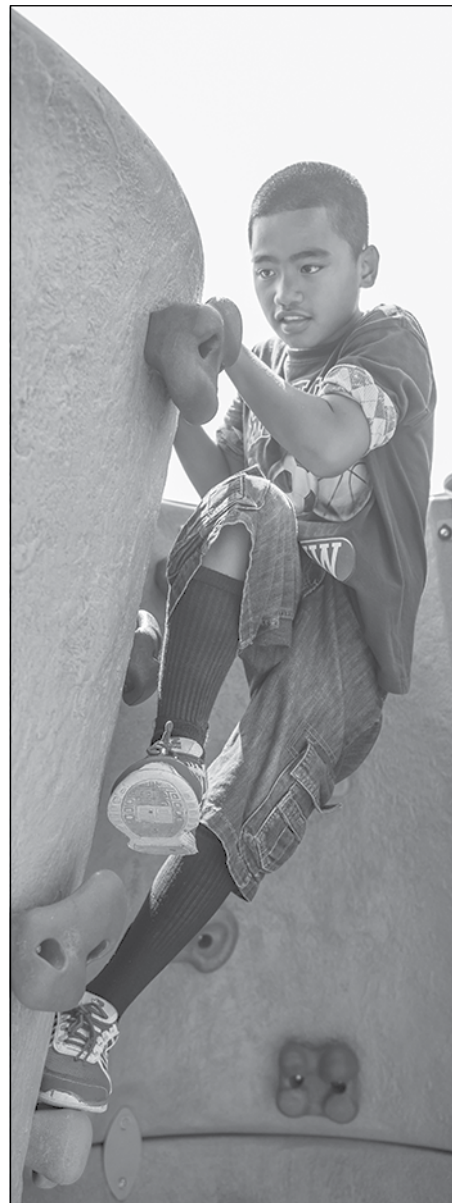
