E FOURTH PLAIN BOULEVARD & FALK ROAD, VANCOUVER

This section of hard-surfaced, shared-use trail follows the Bonneville Power Administration's power line through Meadow Homes Park and soccer fields, crossing 18th Street to Devine Road by way of Burnt Bridge Creek. Following a steep hill just north of Idaho Street, the route then cuts through a shopping center to the Blandford Drive Greenway, which includes both an on-street trail and moderately difficult primitive forest trails with steep grades meandering down the Blandford Drive canyon from MacArthur Boulevard to Evergreen Boulevard.


