


Stewart Glen

NW BERNIE ROAD AND NW FRUIT VALLEY ROAD, VANCOUVER

The beautiful Burnt Bridge Creek Greenway begins at the northwest end of Stewart Glen, at the mouth of Burnt Bridge Creek at Fruit Valley and NW Bernie Drive. This shared-use, hard-surface trail offers excellent opportunities for walking, biking, jogging, commuting, and viewing the Burnt Bridge Creek Greenway. It meanders east along the creek through thick forests and grass bottomlands, and crosses over two bridges to end at Hazel Dell Avenue. On-street bike routes and sidewalks continue the route southeast to Kiggins Bowl, the Ellen Davis Trail and Leverich Park (2 miles).
