- the 68th Washington Legislature passed Substitute Senate Bill 5934, empowering cities, WHEREAS. and counties to promote pollinator-friendly landscaping practices and prohibiting the banning of pollinator habitat and native lawns by cities, counties, and homeowners' associations: and
- WHEREAS, we can support conservation efforts by educating residents, businesses, and community organizations about the importance of pollinators and the role they play in our ecosystem; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Vancouver is committed to promoting sustainable landscaping practices, enhancing green spaces, and fostering a vibrant, pollinator-friendly community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Anne McEnerny-Ogle, Mayor of Vancouver, Washington, do hereby proclaim the 17th-23rd of June as:
