Redevelopment Area Site Plan

- 1,800 residential units
- 900 affordable units (30-80% AMI)
- 60,500 sf ground floor retail
- 1.6-acre Civic Plaza
- 1.6-acre Neighborhood Park
- Linear Park (Grand Loop)
- Accessible, multi-modal street network





Bike Garden and Murals
