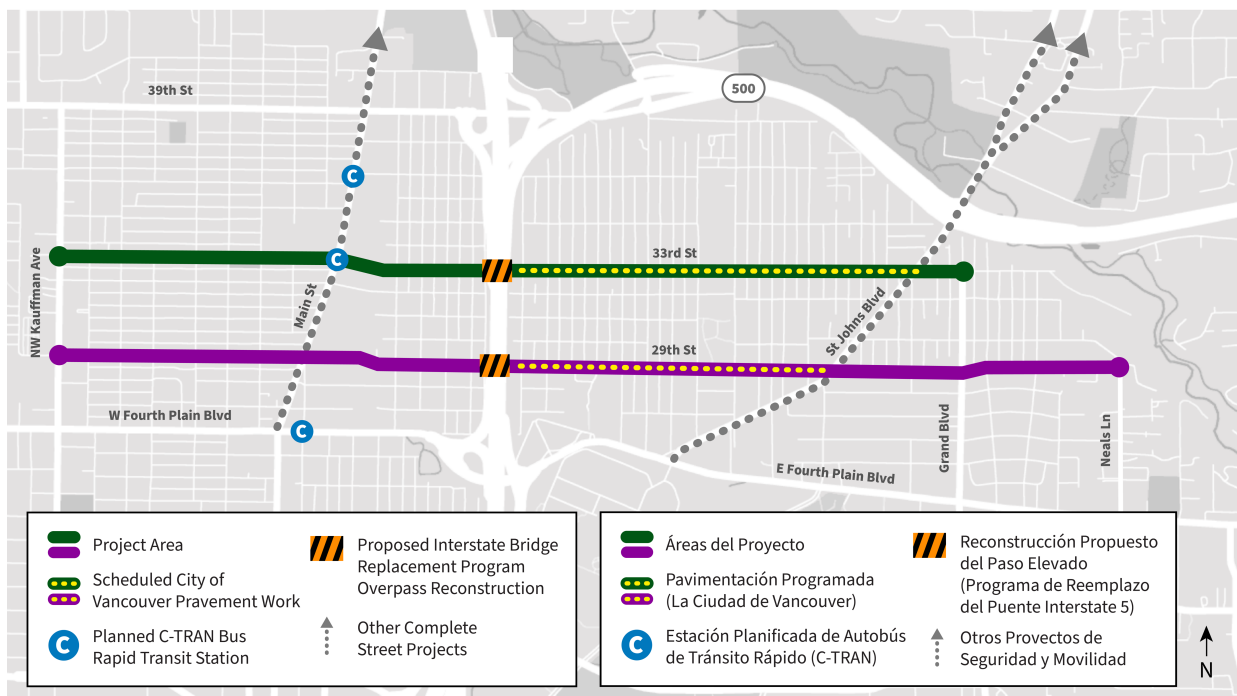
33rd and 29th Safety and Mobility Project Update

This project is exploring how to improve safety and mobility for all people using **29th Street** (between Kauffman Avenue and Neals Lane) and **33rd Street** (between Kauffman Avenue and Grand Boulevard). This will have a significant impact to the Shumway Neighborhood during the different phases of the project.
