# LIFESAVING AWARD

The Lifesaving Award is given to an officer who is directly responsible for the saving of a human life. Documentation and supporting evidence, which may include statements of witnesses, physicians, or supervisors, must be included to substantiate the award. This award is also appropriate in those circumstances where the action of an officer prolonged human life to the extent of the victim being released to the care of medical authorities, even though the victim may have expired at a later time. This award is appropriate for officers who prevent the taking of a life by a suicidal subject through imminent and violent means.

Officer Tyler Knotts Lifesaving Award

On May 20, 2024 Officer Janell Cusick and Officer Tyler Knotts responded to a reported trespasser who had taken some food from a nearby restaurant and had gone over to a vacant building nearby. When they arrived, they located a male slouched over, non-responsive, not breathing and without a pulse. The officers recognized this was a likely drug overdose, proceeded to gather Narcan and began CPR. After several administrations of Narcan and continued CPR a pulse was detected, and CPR was continued until medics arrived. The male regained his ability to breathe on his own and was transported to the hospital. The officers quick response to the medical emergency resulted in saving this person's life.
