Ash Tree Identification



- Narrow bullet shaped body
- Metallic green w/brown head
- Adult beetle 1/2 inch, seen late spring to summer

Affected Ash Tree Signs and Symptoms



- D-shaped exit holes
- Bark Splitting
- Create S shaped galleries in inner bark
- Thinning Canopy and Dieback

What Property Owners Can Do About EAB

- Watch for signs of infestation
- Contact an ISA certified Arborist
- Treat healthy ash or remove if declining
- Replant with other quality shade trees
- Do not move firewood, buy locally
