THIS IS AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR SWIM FACILITY USE between the City of Vancouver ("City") and Clark College ("Clark"), effective September 1, 2014, for use of Vancouver Parks and Recreation aquatics facilities or other pool locations for Clark College's swimming programs for their students; and providing for Interlocal Cooperation Act compliance, ratification, and web-posting in compliance with law.

WHEREAS, The City and Clark College desire to continue to make efficient use of public resources by cooperating in the use of City swim facilities for swim instruction for Clark students.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY AND CLARK COLLEGE AGREE AS FOLLOWS:
