- a- **Columbia View Apartments** Welcome new managers, Caitlynn and Kat! We look forward to meeting you! Yellow speed bumps have been installed and the two security gates are working.
- b- Shorewood Apartments Security System Update "Shorewood Apartments is private property, and anyone that is not a resident, or is not accompanied by a resident of Shorewood Apartments, Shorewood East Condos or Shorewood West Condos, will be considered as trespassing on private property after the hours of 10 pm. Our Security Officers have been notified to stop and ask for identification or proof of residency when they come across any individual or individuals walking the ground after this time including the pond and island area. It is not a public park. Please do not harass the Swans. Feed the wildlife only the food
  - The apartments have 24-hour security cameras found on each corner of the buildings, recording all activity on our property. They strive to keep our residents and our community safe and crime free.
- c- **Shorewood East Condos** The 8-space carport, located on the South Drive, damaged by a wayward bus in March, is being rebuilt. The South drive has also been sealed and coated for winter. SEOA is continuing to provide support for the Wildflower Garden Eagle Scout Project. Brightview Landscape is completing several upgrades and beautification projects to the property. Safety is the primary concern, but we all enjoy the view.

- d- **Shorewood West Condos** Several condominiums are for sale at both West and East Condos, and the city has asked that all real estate signs on Shorewood Drive be removed. Shorewood West is also reporting some damage to their outdoor furniture by squirrels.
- e- Evergreen Pointe Apartments and Trees Mobile Home Park no update
- f- **Neighborhood Assn.** volunteers have continued to work on the Wildflower Garden by removing ivy, laying weed cloth, and spreading chips. Two **Evergreen Shores** volunteers have provided benches. NA has applied for a city grant for added mulch, seeds, and chips.
- g- Multi-Neighborhood Cleanup held June 29th at Vancouver Middle School South Parking Lot was very successful. **12.19 tons** of bulky items collected; **2.73 tons** of yard debris collected; plus, scrap metal.
- h- Several residents are concerned about the traffic speeds on Evergreen Blvd and Shorewood Drive. Please follow the Radar Feedback signs that encourage all drivers to go 25 mph.
