Domestic Animals and Livestock - Municipal code 20.895.050 - Poultry & Rabbits.

Turkeys, Roosters and Peacocks are **NOT** permitted.

Animal noise control – Municipal code 8.24.130

To report a barking dog, you need to have a recording of the barking for 10 minutes at one time or several shorter videos that add up to 30 minutes in a 24-hour period.

Animals-- Running at large – Municipal code 8.24.110 – Cats are allowed to roam, but dogs are **NOT** allowed except at off leash dog parks.

It is illegal to have bad odor on your property that affects the ability for your neighbors to use their outdoor property.
